## Oregon and Washington Priority Tributaries

The states of Oregon and Washington have designated various lower Columbia River tributaries as priorities for restoration and conservation in their salmon and steelhead recovery plans. Overall priority stream designations are indicated according to the following map legend:

Highest (Fall Chinook AND Chum)

High (Fall Chinook OR Chum)

Medium

Individual priority levels were established for specific fish populations, or ESUs (evolutionary significant unit) that spawn in lower Columbia tributaries. Priority scores can be seen for the following ESU's, by clicking on a stream feature in the map:

Spring Chinook, Fall Chinook, Late Fall Chinook, Coho, Chum, Winter Steelhead, Summer Steelhead
