### Creston Annex Head Start Stormwater Project

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## Project Overview

The Creston Annex Head Start Stormwater Project (4620 SE Powell Blvd, Portland, OR 97206) managed by the Lower Columbia Estuary Partnership will capture and treat stormwater and provide nature play opportunities for students. The western portion of asphalt parking lot will be retrofit with vegetated stormwater facilities and sidewalks, permeable pavers will replace the eastern portion of the parking lot and alley, and the northeastern turf area will be landscaped with native plantings and outdoor play elements for students. The project was developed by KPFF in collaboration with Learning Landscapes and Portland Public Schools (PPS).

This is a BOLI prevailing wage project, and bidder must be able to meet City of Portland insurance requirements outlined in the General Conditions, section 10.

## Preparation, Submittal and Opening of Bids

All blanks of the Bid Form must be completed electronically or in ink, and signed. A Bid price shall be indicated for each item. All names must be typed or printed in ink below the signature. Any individual or entity (other than a supplier) having a direct contract with Bidder for performance or furnishing more than \$30,000 of Work at the Site shall be listed on the Bid Form. The address and telephone number for communications regarding the Bid must be shown.

Bids will be opened in private and a list of bidders and total bid prices will not be released.

Addenda may be issued to clarify, correct, or change the Bidding Documents as deemed advisable by Estuary Partnership. Bidder shall acknowledge receipt of Addenda on the Bid Form.

## Selection Criteria

60 Points	<b>Bid Price</b>
	Bid prices as provided on the Bid Form.
10 Points	<b>Schedule and Approach</b>
	Bidder's ability to schedule work to meet Portland Public School's requirement of substantial completion by August 14, 2026, and bidder's understanding of the Work.
10 Points	<b>MBE/WBE</b>
	Bidder and subcontractor's MBE/WBE designation and certification number, if applicable.
20 Points	<b>Qualifications</b>
	Qualifications and experience of the bidder with green infrastructure or related projects.

## Award of Contract and Signing of Agreement

Within ten days after the day of the Bid opening, the Estuary Partnership will give successful bidder a Notice of Award, and will inform other bidders of unsuccessful bids.

When Owner gives a Notice of Award to the successful bidder, it will be accompanied by the Agreement for signature. Within fourteen days thereafter the successful bidder shall sign and send the Agreement and attached documents to Owner. Within fourteen days thereafter, Estuary Partnership shall deliver one fully signed counterpart to successful bidder.
